## **BE A PRAYER WARRIOR**

*We find these words in Acts 12:5, "But while Peter was in prison the church prayed very earnestly for him."*

**Peter had been put in prison by King Herod. He was placed under the watchful eye of 16 Navy Seal-like soldiers, and he was bound in chains and secured behind three doors deep within the prison. The soldiers were told, "If he tries to escape, kill him."**

**And what could the church do? They had no recourse: no clout and no political chips to cash.**

They began praying for Peter. They had an ally bigger than their problem. In a short time an angel appeared in Peter's prison cell, his chains fell off his wrists and the angel set him free.

Our passionate prayers move the heart of God. I like what James said, "The effective fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much." (James 5:16) Prayer requires minimal effort. You can pray anywhere, no location is prescribed. No particular clothing is required. No title of office is stipulated. Prayer is simply telling God what is on our heart.

Every Monday morning our church staff prays for those on our church prayer list. We usually have between 30 and 50 names on our prayer list. It recently occurred to me that our church needs a prayer team of laity. A prayer team is a group of church members who commit to praying for those on our prayer list.

Let me tell you how this can work at Shandon. Those who would like to be a part of our prayer team should e-mail Karen Daves at [kdaves@shandon-umc.org](mailto:kdaves@shandon-umc.org) and express the desire to be a part of our team. Every Monday afternoon Karen will e-mail the group the updated prayer list. Members of the group commit to praying for those on our list at least once a week. The Reverend Ted McCutchen has agreed to head up our prayer ministry. Periodically he will e-mail the group some devotional material about the importance of prayer and how to pray. Ted is dedicated to prayer and is willing to coach our prayer team.

Like the church in Jerusalem, we need a group of members devoted to prayer because prayer makes a difference. If you would like to be prayed for by this group fill out a prayer card which you can find each Sunday in our pew racks or e-mail or call Karen and request to be put on the list.

Don't forget if you want to be part of our prayer team e-mail Karen within the next two weeks and let her know you are willing to be a prayer warrior for our church.

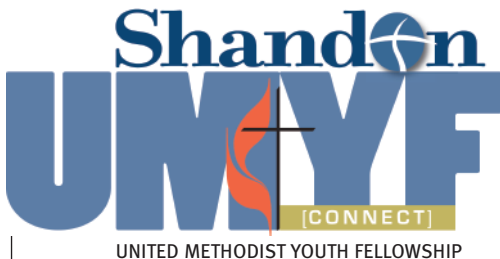
