## OBSERVING LENT

*Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 18.*

*Lent is a season of 40 days reminiscent of the 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness.*

**This is a time to renew our spiritual lives in order to be spiritually prepared to celebrate Jesus crucifixion and resurrection.**

The disciplines of Lent are prayer, confession, repentance, self-denial, spiritual discipline and fasting. Some people deny themselves something for Lent and others take on something. The whole point of Lent is that we focus on activities that help us draw closer to Christ. Someone asked me the other day what they can do to observe Lent. In case you are struggling with that same question, let me give you several suggestions.

- Identify a family meal where everyone in the family is present, breakfast or dinner works best. Share a passage of scripture with your family and lead them in prayer. The scripture might focus on the words of Jesus from the gospels, and the prayer might focus on a theme or word in that scripture passage. Remember Sundays are not part of Lent, so you simply attend church with your family on Sunday.
- Get a jar and make it your Lenten jar. Write down 40 tasks, one per slip of paper. Then each morning pull one out and do it. The tasks might be a visit to a lonely person, write a letter to a friend, do something nice for a neighbor, or pray for a person in need.
- Instead of listening to the radio in your car, take time for prayer. Pray for your family, a homeless person on the side of the street, a person being rushed to the hospital in an ambulance, a church you drive by, or the person in the car in front of you.
- As you interact with people each day look for Jesus in their lives and celebrate their faith. Be intentional each day to let your light shine before others.
- Each day of Lent write a note to thank someone who has had a positive impact on your life in some way. This will help you build up goodness in them and their kindness will continue to inspire you.
- Make an altar in your home with a simple cross, a table covered with a purple cloth, and two candles. Gather around this altar each day of Lent and have a family devotion.
- Gather with co-workers and share a devotion during your lunch break.

Find ways to make Lent come alive for yourself and/or your family. Be creative and let the Spirit lead you. Let us all observe a holy Lent. -In Faith, Michael Guffee, Sr.

# Parking IN the FIRE LANE

*From the Property Committee*

On any recent Sunday morning, the **entire length** of the outer curb of our driveway through the parking lot and behind the Knox Building had cars parked in the NO PARKING / FIRE LANE zone. There were places where it was “tight” for a normal car to negotiate. This FIRE LANE is a safety requirement established by the State Code and is enforced by the City Fire and City Police Departments. Parking in this FIRE LANE can severely limit fire and emergency medical response. What if someone has an emergency, say a heart attack or stroke where every second counts and an ambulance can not get around the building?

This safety problem is something that our church family needs to address together. While we wish we could provide up-close parking to everyone, especially on rainy days, we **MUST** obey this safety requirement. The Fire Department says that if a fire truck needs to come through there during an emergency, they will get through one way or the other. I personally would not want to explain to my insurance company why my vehicle was parked in an illegal parking location. We are not sure if either the church’s insurance policy or your auto insurance will cover this risk.

The Property Committee is politely asking that everyone obey the NO PARKING, FIRE LANE. Our parking lot across Devine Street normally has parking spaces available, and we pay for the crossing guard to assist with safely crossing the street on Sunday mornings. There is also parking at Dreher High School. Thank you for your help.
