## *Staying on Course*

*Morris Ashcraft, a seminary professor, recalled the days of his naval aviation.*

He recalled that as a naval aviator of a single engine carrier aircraft it was necessary for them to fly in formation. Sometimes they would fly in formations of three, twelve and sixteen planes. This was of particular significance when they were flying into cloud formations with no visibility. They would fly with one wing overlapping the wing of the next plane, so that in low visibility they would always see the wing of the plane next to them. He stated, “While we were in the clear, we trimmed the controls of the plane, and the aircraft was on course and steady before we entered the clouds. We would be in zero visibility in formation with one wing tip over the other. We would think about those props going 1800 rpm and hope that everyone stayed in formation. Because we were on course and steady as we entered the clouds, the way we went in is the way we came out.”

He went on to say that many times when he was leading a squadron, 11 planes would go into the clouds behind him and 11 planes would come out of the clouds in exact formation. Because they went in on course and steady, they came out the same way.

Life under God is like that. When all is well and God is in heaven and all seems bright and right in our world, we should build memories of God’s faithfulness. Then when the clouds of difficulty appear, we will be on course. In times of grief, illness, loss, confusion and misdirection, we can count on God’s past remembered faithfulness to give us future guidance and comfort.

Prayer is the lens through which we look back at God’s guidance in the past and the telescope with which we see God’s guidance in the future. Let’s make sure we live our lives trusting and depending on God so that when difficulty comes to us, trust and dependence on God comes naturally and easily.

I look forward to seeing all of you Sunday morning. Sunday is Commitment Day for our capital campaign. Make sure you are present and don’t forget to complete and bring your commitment card with you to church.

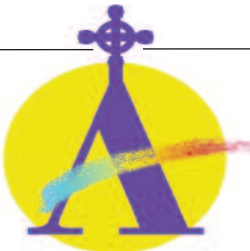
