MY JOURNEY WITH BREAST CANCER

Ten years ago, in December 2004, I was diagnosed with breast cancer. I had been “persuaded” by Nancy Reynolds to take advantage of having my overdue mammogram done on the Palmetto Health Mobile Mammography Van, which was coming to Shandon. I agreed, but, to be honest, I really was not convinced that a mammogram taken on a van was a clinically-sound practice. Boy, did I get a surprise when I was called ten days later with my diagnosis! I will be cancer-free for ten years in May, 2015, and I consider Kathy Ayen from the mobile mammography van to be my guardian angel. I know that my visit to the van that day quite possibly saved my life, and I am now their biggest cheerleader.

The Palmetto Health Mobile Mammography Van is making its yearly visit to Shandon on Thursday, December 4, sponsored by the Health and Wellness Committee, and will be located at the Exxon Service Station across the street from the church. Women wishing to schedule a mammogram should be 40 years or older and present proof of insurance. A doctor’s order will no longer be required. (For any woman younger than 40, a doctor’s order is required.) To register for your mammogram, call (803) 296-8888 or go online at www.palmettohealth.org (click on Appointment, at the top of the page, and fill out form; then click on Pre-register, at the top of the page, and fill out form.) You must complete steps 1 & 2 to insure that you have an appointment. Scheduling will call you back with an appointment time.

I strongly encourage all eligible women at Shandon to consider making this commitment to your health. Breast cancer is the leading killer of women 35-55. One in eight women will have breast cancer, and mammography is the most effective tool in the diagnosis of breast cancer. Please join us on December 4 — it is easy, fast and convenient and could be a life-saver. It was for me! For more information, call me, Margaret Hays, at (803)787-6892.
