One year ago the National Weather Service recorded 21.49 inches of rain at its Gills Creek station, 17.71 inches at Fort Jackson, and 15.89 inches at Hopkins.

What happened to the covenant between God and the earth? Well, to be perfectly fair to the biblical text, it says "never again will all flesh be cut off by the waters of a flood." And as catastrophic as the flood was, it didn't "cut off all flesh."

For those interested in digging deeper theologically, Old Testament scholar Terrence Fretheim has written a profound little book entitled *Creation Untamed: The Bible, God, and Natural Disasters*. Fretheim says, "God created a dynamic world" – a world in the process of becoming – and "human beings may be hurt by the becoming of the world." As much as we may want things to be different, "The world God created is not (and never has been) a risk-free place, and God has not provided danger-free zones for righteous people." Part of the beauty and glory of God's creation is its energy and unpredictability – and therefore to some extent its danger.

But of course the awesomeness of God's creation is not the only lesson we learned last October. We also learned the power of love. We learned that tragedy is an opportunity for service. In my short time at Shandon, I've heard story after story of friends, family, and the church reaching out to neighbors in need. This was not just the work of human do-gooders: it was the love of God at work in the world through human instruments. Ultimately the most powerful thing in God's creation is not the forces of nature. The most powerful force in God's creation is love – love even in the face of tragedy.

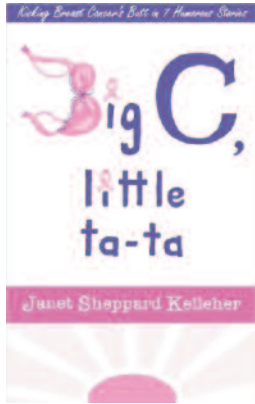
